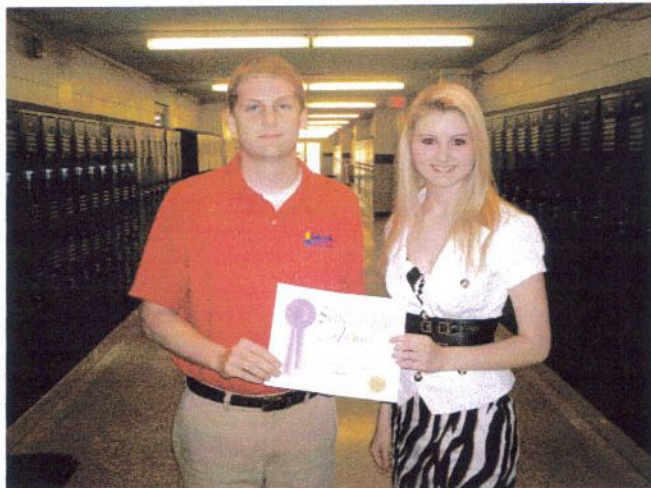


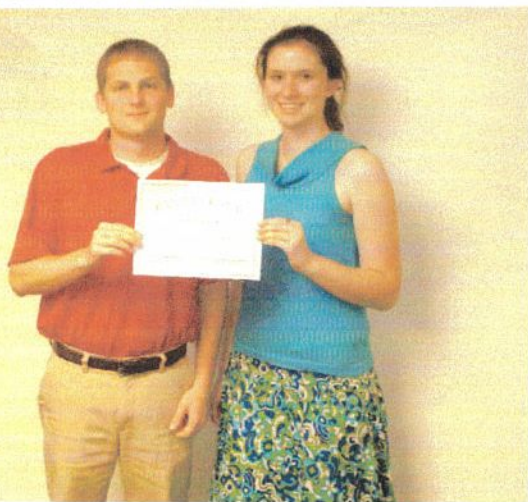
Lakeside Credit Union Announces Scholarship Winners
